Friends and Colleagues,

It has been a couple of months since we posted the last Broadvision. We apologise for the delay, which was inevitable due to the ongoing issues concerning the court case on recognition to Staff Associations. The CAT, Delhi in the case filed by the three General Secretaries on behalf of the three Associations (ARTEE, ADTEA & PSA) has now directed the department to complete the process of recognition before 30<sup>th</sup> of June, i.e four months from 29.02.2012. We hope that the process shall be complete by then, and PSA will be back in the forefront of collective bargaining for the welfare of cadres. A lot of issues have been happening in the last few months and our Association had called a Central Executive Committee meeting on 16.02.2012 to discuss certain issues apart from the National Convention that was scheduled on 23 & 24.02.2012. The meeting was attended by several of the members and the following resolutions were passed unanimously,

1. All the members present in the CEC meeting were of the view that as per consultations with the State & Zonal Secretaries of the Association the National Convention/General Body meeting should be postponed by a few months till the ongoing Association recognition process was over. It was felt by all the members present that the interim gap could be used for mobilizing the members to make the recognition process a grand success. Hence it has been decided to postpone the National Convention / General Body meeting, and the new dates shall be announced in April-May,2012.
2. All the members also felt that the proforma collection among members for the check-off system should be more thoroughly done and that every unit should also send a copy of the already submitted proforma to Prasar Bharati as well. The communication should be addressed to the Manager (Personnel), Prasar Bharati, PTI Building, Second Floor, Sansad Marg, New Delhi-110001.

3. All the members present felt that any nuisance creator against the interest of PSA should be proceeded against as per law, and there should be no slackening of efforts on that front.
4. The members also felt that if the MACP process for the left out PEXs & TREXs are not complete by 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2012, we should then request all members who have not received their MACP to write to the Directorate seeking issuance of their MACP orders. The profoma for the representation is to be circulated by the central unit.
5. The members were also briefed by the General Secretary on the eleven ongoing cases where PSA is an applicant or Respondent. All the members are now hopeful that the long pending and complicated Review DPC in the JTS Cadre shall be resolved by the DOPT not later than March, 2012.

As decided in the November CEC Meeting, Dr.S.K.Nahar, PEX & Executive Vice-President and Sh.Pankaj Pati Pathak, TREX shall attend any meeting called by the Management for clarifications on the recognition process. They shall also be helped by Sh.P.S.Tapliyal, PEX, who has been nominated as the Secretary (Co-ordination) in place of Dr.Uma Shankar Singh, TREX, who has left on deputation. All the members are requested to contact Dr.S.K.Nahar (Mob:09868322370), Pankaj Pati Pathak (Mob:098103557360), Ms.Sadna Bhardwaj (Mob:09958501029) and P.S.Tapliyal (Mob: 09560672228) regarding any clarifications they might have concerning MACP or other issues.
