

Sub: Inordinate and undue delay in the issuance of MACP for PEXs & TREXs.  
Ref: Earlier letters of PSA dated 24.11.2011, 01.10.2011 and several letters of 2009 & 2010.

Respected Sir,

Namaste. We wish to bring to your kind attention the fact that hundreds of PEXs & TREXs working in AIR & DD through out the country are yet to get their first MACP, and the inordinate delay is a **painful fact requiring your kind and urgent attention**. It shall not be out of place to mention here that the MACP orders of other cadres like the Production Assistants, Floor Managers, Cameramen, Assistant Engineers, Senior Engineering Assistants, Engineering Assistants and Technicians are being periodically issued. There seems to be a total neglect of MACP orders concerning PEXs and TREXs. In this context a recent MACP order for Production Assistants issued by the Doodarshan Directorate ( **No.15/13/2010-SI dated 01.02.2012-copy attached**) is a classical example of where **the second MACP** orders of upto 2011 have been completed for the cadre, while **even the first MACP order for over 300 TREXs & PEXs is yet to be issued**. We are happy that our colleagues in Doordarshan are getting their due benefits well within time whereas, the same is unnecessarily delayed for their colleagues working in AIR & DD stations through out the counrty. In this context, we wish to bring to your kind attention the fact that all the Programme cadres

are working under tremendous pressure due to shortage of staff in field stations on the one hand and stagnation due to lack of promotions on the other hand. In this scenario MACP is the only benefit that has come to the Programme staff after a long time/struggle. **Now even that is being delayed beyond all reasons, leading to frustration among the Programme Staff.** We request your kind self to look into it personally and direct the concerned sections to issue the long pending MACP orders of PEXs & TREXs working in AIR & DD stations through out the country in a **time bound manner**, so as to grant a minimal financial relief to the cadres.
